 - a. Estimated cost \$2 million to replace bridge and improve existing bridge, must comply with environmental regulations & budget
 - b. Schedule final design (now thru 2025), permitting & right of way acquisition (2025), construction starting after Memorial Day 2026. Close road, implement detour (5/26/26). Will be times during construction where they will allow travel. Mostly complete by Labor Day, overall done 9/30/26.
 - c. New bridge Will be 12 ft wider. No dredging (10.5 ft deep currently). Will be 1.5 ft higher. Will have 12 ft lanes and 6 ft shoulders on road. Will limit access to landing (4 weeks impassible). We will want to have boats in water by Memorial Day weekend. County will have updates on their webpage.
